## Academic Achievement Scholarship Application

Application requires Adobe PDF Reader or Adobe Acrobat. Adobe PDF Reader can be downloaded at <u>http://get.adobe.com/reader/</u>. When completing the application using Adobe PDF Reader, please note that you cannot save your data once it is entered into the form. Once the application is completed, you must print the application and provide the printed copy to the appropriate individuals for signature. If you have access to Adobe Acrobat you will be able to save your form data, as needed.

Applicant must be a Black male graduating senior who attends high school (i.e., charter, independent, parochial, private, or public) in Washington, DC.

The following instructions are provided to assist you in completing the Alpha Omega Chapter Academic Achievement Scholarship Application. Each numbered instruction below corresponds with the same numbered question on the application. All responses should be typed into the fields provided. Each text (data entry) field is identified by a black border.

- 1. Fill out all applicable fields in their entirety. The form will automatically format the data entered.
- 2. When entering address information, please enter the data as follows:

Name Street Address 1 Street Address 2 (if necessary) City, State, Zip Code

- 3. When entering telephone number information, please type all 10 digits with no dashes or spaces. The form will automatically format the data entered. When entering date information into the date field, use the convention DD/MM/YYYY. If you enter dates in any other way, the form will not accept the data.
- 4. Enter the complete name of the high school you attend.
- 5. When entering date information into the date field, use the convention DD/MM/YYYY. If you enter dates in any other way, the form will not accept the data.
- 6. List all extracurricular activities. Separate each activity with a comma.
- 7. Answer "Yes" or "No" to the question in the small text box provided. If yes, list each school you have applied to, one in each box provided, with the respective dates of acceptance.
- 8. Type your essay directly into the text box provided.



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- 9. Enter preferred time of day for a telephone interview, use the convention HH:MM.
- 10. Provide two (2) letters of recommendation.
- 11. Complete certification section.

**Remember** to include your **official high school transcript** when sending your application to the P. O. Box. If you will send your application to the email address, your guidance counselor must send your **official high school transcript**.

Your applications should be mailed to the Alpha Omega Scholarship Committee at the address below. Be sure to include all required information. Do not include application instructions in your submittal.
